So, let's get going!

Action points for your organisation

- Set your fundraising goals.
- Choose the type of fundraiser you're going to run.
- Decide on what areas to focus on: ticket sales, sponsorship, race card advertisements etc.
- Develop target contributors, e.g. sponsors & race card advertisers.
- Create a target-specific fundraising strategy.
- Create your sales pitch.
- Draft your pitch letters. Organise mailings, meetings & phone calls.

Fundraising: Choose the way that's best for you

We will offer a number, or all of the following opportunities to maximise the financial return for your organisation.

1 Small - Ticket Sales

Funds from €1,000 to €6,000

2 Medium - Buster Race

Funds from €6,000 to €14,000

3 Large - Monster Benefit Night

Funds from €14,000 to €100,000



FUNDRAISING

1 Small - Ticket Sales

Funds from €1,000 to €6,000

How it works...

- The stadium gives your fundraising committee pre-printed tickets, each entitling the bearer to entrance and race card to the stadium
- Your committee sells the tickets at €10 per ticket
- The day before the event, your committee meets with the stadium and gives back the unsold tickets, paying €3 or €4 (depending on the night) for the tickets that were sold. Your profit is €6 or €7, multiplied by the number of tickets sold.

Example: Your committee receives 500 tickets from the stadium, of which 400 tickets are sold at €10 each, a total of €4,000

The committee then returns the 100 unsold tickets and pays €4 for the 400 tickets sold, i.e. €1,600 is the charge for the event.

Total profit to your fundraising committee of €2,400

EXAMPLE ONLY

Sell 400 tickets at €10	€4,000
Charge to stadium of €3 per ticket	€1,200
Profit	€2,800

FUNDRAISING

2 Medium - Buster Race

Funds from €6,000 to €14,000

How it works...

- One race is assigned to your fundraising committee
- Each race has 6 dogs
- There are 720 different combinations of which order the dogs can finish in that race, e.g. 452613, 654321, 254631 etc..
- Each combination is printed on a ticket
- Each ticket holder gains Entrance & Race Card to the stadium on the night of the Buster Race
- The person with the ticket showing the combination of how the dogs finished in that race wins a cash prize (that your organisation puts up).

EXAMPLE ONLY

Sell 720 Tickets at €20 each (Admits 2 Adults & 2 Children) **€14,400**

Sponsor **€1,000**

Prize Money Cost (set by you) **€1,000**

(For the buster ticket with the winning combination)

Stadium Costs **€2,000**

Includes:

- Additional prize money for Buster Race for greyhound owners
- Race named after your organisation or sponsor
- Admission & Race Card for all who purchase Buster tickets
- Trophy to present to the winning dog
- Photographs and information sent to Local Press - great publicity
- Sheet for winning dog with committee or sponsor name on it

Printing Costs **€500 (est)**

Net Profit **€11,900**

FUNDRAISING

3 Large - Monster Benefit

Funds from €14,000 to €100,000

How it works...

A Monster Benefit Night offers you many options on how to proceed.

There is no limit on the number of tickets your organisation can sell for your night.

Eleven (11) races are made available for your committee to sell sponsorship for.

If your organisation chooses to print your own race card you have the option to do any of the following:

- Sell race card advertisements
- Dog nominators can also be sold for each race
- Restaurant tables can be sold at a profit and your organisation can run a raffle in the stadium on the night and sell to all stadium patrons.

Our Fundraising Models

3 Large - Monster Benefit

Funds from €14,000 to €100,000

EXAMPLE ONLY Figures as a guide only

1,000 General Admission tickets at €10 each (Admits 1 Adult)	€10,000
Restaurant Tables, €45 pp, sell at €60 pp, €15 profit pp (subject to T's & C's)	€1,000
Sponsorship of 11 races at €600 per race (You set the price)	€6,600
Raffle on the night	€2,000
Race card advertisements 50 at €150 each (A5 page advertisements printed in race card)	€7,500
Dog Nominators 66 at €50 each	€3,300
Total Income	€30,400

COSTS

Stadium	€4,000
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Admission for all ticket holders• Extra Prize Money contributed to sponsored races• Information sent to local press to advertise your event• Sheet for winning dog with your organisations name• Trophy for your organisation to present to the winning dog of the Main Sponsors Race• Photographs of Sponsors sent to local press• Promotional Opportunities for Main Sponsors around the Stadium.	

Printing Costs	€1,000 (est)
Net Profit	€25,500
